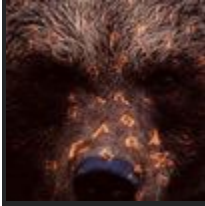
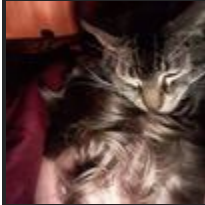


Goði Sol - CoRS



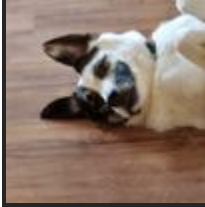

We're up to 511 members, a gain of 12 over last month. I only declined one application, and it was due to a lack of response on the inclusivity question.

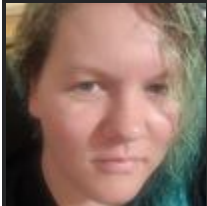
